◆ Mira Costa High school ranks in the top 1.3% of public high schools in California with a 2010 API of 898.

◆ 100 percent of all MBUSD certificated teachers were NCLB compliant in 2009-2010.

◆ The Manhattan Beach Education Foundation and PTAs support programs and services such as libraries, science specialists, lower class sizes, technology, reading specialists, music, computer specialists, health assistants, and classroom supplies totaling in excess of \$5.5 million annually.

Other post-graduate choices include military, mission work, technical study, and the work force.

◆ Mira Costa HS has over 600 students in 18 Advanced Placement courses.

◆ 25 career technical education courses are offered at Mira Costa HS in partnership with the Southern California Regional Occupational Center.

◆ MBUSD has developed strong partnerships with the City of Manhattan Beach, Chevron, Northrop Grumman, and BCHD.

◆ Measure BB will soon bring a \$53 million renovation project to MCHS.

- * Grand View and Pacific Elementary Schools were recognized in 2010 as California Distinguished Schools. Manhattan Beach Middle School was honored as a California Distinguished School in 2009.
