

"The Jazz Fly" by Matthew Gollub ; illustrated by Karen Hanke

Instructions for making a jazz fly to take home:

Supplies: Black, white, red construction paper; glue sticks; crayons or markers

Prep: With the die cut machine cut out one black circle for the body, two white circles for the eyes, and one lower case red letter "c" for the smile. Our circle has a 5" diameter and that size was easy for the kindergarteners to manipulate.

1. Glue the red "c" onto the black circle so it makes a smile.
2. Glue the two white circles side by side (some of the smile will be covered) so they make the eyes. They will hang outside of the head, like a cartoon character.
3. Embellish the eyes with crayons or markers.
