Parents of 5th grade students, you and your child have the opportunity to participate in Manhattan Beach Middle School's first "MBMS Night". This evening's program will answer some of your questions regarding the transition from elementary school to middle school. If you have older children, you will see some resemblance to "Mira Costa Night at MBMS", the program the high school puts on for 8th grade families. We will start the evening in the Multi Purpose Room at MBMS at 6:00pm on Tuesday, January 7, 2014. (We start programs right on time at MBMS, so 6:00 means 6:00.) I will say a few words and we will hear from a couple of students. We will then break into smaller groups in rooms throughout the campus. These rooms will be manned by students, MBMS parents and a MBMS staff member. Our parents and staff members will be there to offer a different, adult perspective. In this smaller setting the students will tell the story of their journey from 5th to 6th grade. They will also touch on their 7th and 8th grade years here at MBMS. Next will be the question and answer period where you and/or your child can ask questions of the students, parents, or staff member. After about 30 minutes we will switch rooms and do the whole thing over again. Hopefully at the end of the 1 ½ hour program you will better understand the process and be informed about the various transitional activities.
