

GRADE 3—SLQB 2024 Reading List

Every participating student is asked to read at least 9 books.

*Super Literacy Quiz Bowl is a fast-paced trivia game based on all the books listed below. Students in the same grade level compete as teams during the school day; students are placed randomly into teams within their class. Competition dates will be announced when registration opens after winter break. You **must** turn in a signed registration form to compete—no exceptions.*

HELPFUL HINTS

- Start reading! All titles are available at the Grand View library: picture books stay at the library; chapter books will be circulated in a timely manner to give everyone a chance.
- Consider checking out books through the public library system. Or you could buy a copy; some of these are real keepers.
- Take notes. Dedicate a notebook for all your SLQB books. It will be really helpful for review before the competition. **However, do not bring notes to the competition.*
- Keep track of straightforward information, even things like names of the author and illustrator. List character names. Jot down sequence and timeline of events. These are the kind of details that will help you during the game.
- Read everything in each book. This means the supplementary pages, like the foreword and the afterword, included in many nonfiction books. The “extra” stuff makes great SLQB questions.
- Have fun!
